

# Roman blind fitting instructions

The installation pack will include sufficient brackets and screws for the fitting of your roman blinds.

The roman blinds are available in two styles - Classic and Soft Fold. The classic style gives the fabric a smooth, even finish while the soft fold option allows the fabric to cascade down the blind. Both styles are installed using identical procedures.

## Fitting with 'hidden' brackets

The blinds can be installed as either a face or top fix. Place one bracket at either side of the headrail, 100mm in from each end, then space the remaining brackets evenly between the two. Loosen the holding plate at the base of each bracket sufficiently to accommodate the sculptured headrail using a screwdriver. Push the rail into the brackets and then tighten the holding plate to secure the blind in place.

## Operating your blinds

To lower the blind hold the control cord in a vertical position and pull it downwards slightly to release the cord locking mechanism. Keeping hold of the cord allow the blind to drop or unfurl slowly to the desired position. Pull the cord to the side of the blind to lock the mechanism then release the cord. To raise the blind pull the cord until the blind is at the required level and move the cord to the side to lock it in place.

## Important

In the interests of child safety it is advisable to fasten all cords around a cord tidy and keep out of the reach of children.
